



Chapter 2

Multicolored fabric to fabric

With this technique you can create a fun colorful appliqué on top of a foundation fabric without sewing.

You need:

- Light blue wool foundation fabric
- Multicolored checked wool fabric for the circles
- Pfaff fabric marking pen part no 412 7525-01
- Pfaff Appliqué Template 1 part no 412 73 49-01
- Printed layout design template for the front piece of the cushion
- Fabric scissors
- hobby™ 350p punching machine

1 Cutting

From light blue wool fabric (for the cushion front piece):
One piece 44 x 44 cm (17,5" x 17,5")

- From multicolored wool fabric: Two pieces 44 x 9 cm (17,5" x 3,5")

2 Embellish/felting/punching

- Lay the Pfaff Appliqué Template 1 on top of the multicolored checked wool pieces. Use the Pfaff fabric marking pen and trace all three circles referring to the printed layout design template for placement of the circles.
- Place the multicolored stripes on the wrong side of the light blue wool fabric cushion front with the drawn circles up as shown in the layout diagram.
- Start in the center of each circle and "needle" loosely moving over all of the circles to "baste" the stripes in place. Then let the machine "needle" moving over entire circles until it is embellished enough. Make sure that you in each of the circles only needle in the inner and the outer circles; leave the circle in the middle without any needling. Turn your project over to the right side periodically to check where you need to needle more.
